COVID-19 Lampasas County Courtroom Guidelines June 1, 2020

The following information is taken from the COVID-19 Operating Plan for the Lampasas County Judiciary, which includes the 27th District Court, County Court, Justices of the Peace Courts, Child Abuse and Neglect Court and the IV-D Child Support Court.

To ensure the health and safety of litigants, attorneys, visitors, court staff, judges and other individuals entering the courts of Lampasas County, the following protective measures will be taken:

- By coming to work, court or entering the courtroom, you are affirming that you are symptom free and have not knowingly been in contact with any person diagnosed with or suspected to be infected with COVID-19 within the prior 14 days.
- Observe signage regarding entering and exiting the building as well as using stairs/elevator and entering and exiting the courtroom.
- Wear protective face covering (If you do not have a protective face covering, a disposable face covering will be provided to you)
- Practice social distancing and personal hygiene.
- Upon entering the courtroom your temperature MAY be taken using an infrared thermometer and individuals with temperature equal to or exceeding 100 degrees or those who decline to submit to having their temperature taken will be directed to leave the courtroom.
