

LAMPASAS & SAN SABA JOINT COUNTY BROADBAND INITIATIVE

WHO IS INVOLVED? The Lampasas and San Saba Counties' Joint Broadband Committee is comprised of local community leaders from various sectors with a common mission of enhancing and expanding broadband access, adoption and use throughout our communities for the benefit of residents and businesses. To that end, the Committee has partnered with Connected Nation Texas and their "Connected Community" program to assess the present state of broadband in Lampasas and San Saba Counties and establish a broadband planning process and plan to address our current and future broadband needs.

WHAT IS BEING DONE? To perform an assessment of Lampasas and San Saba Counties' current broadband environment, the Committee will be conducting surveys of residents, businesses, and other organizations across the counties. Responses to these surveys will help us better understand the existing resources and capabilities we have. After a structured evaluation of this assessment, we will then develop appropriate action plans and projects to improve our broadband environment most effectively.

WHEN WILL THIS TAKE PLACE? Our Joint Community Broadband Assessment and related surveys will be launched in April and continue into the June timeframe. Results from this work will be shared with the public, followed by additional work to develop a county-wide Action Plan to address identified areas of need.
