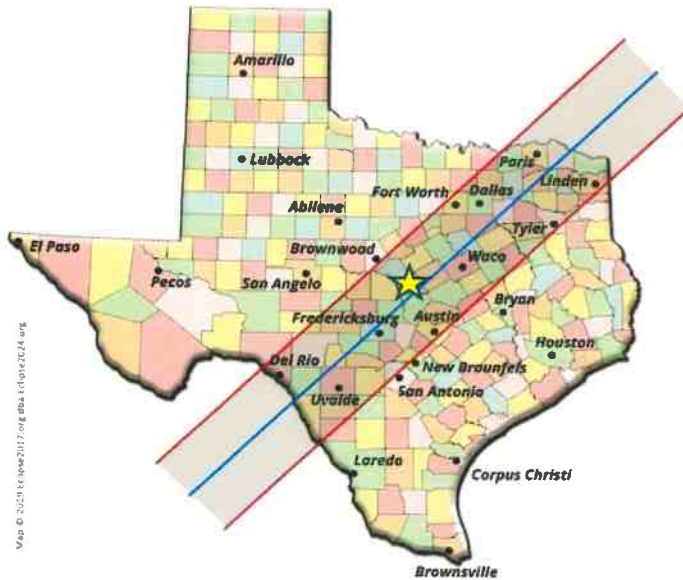

  - Totality Phase Begins: 1:35.26 P.M.
  - Duration: 4 minutes 24.3 seconds
- City Of Lometa
  - Partial Phase Begins: 12:18.05 P.M.
  - Totality Phase Begins: 1:29.10 P.M.
  - Duration: 4 minutes 11.9 seconds
- City of Kempner
  - Partial Phase Begins: 12:18.23 P.M.
  - Totality Phase Begins: 1:35.46 P.M.
  - Duration: 4 minutes 23.5 seconds

## How OUR Community can prepare for this Event:

- From April 5<sup>th</sup> to April 9, 2024, people should have a supply of food, water, fuel, medication, etc...
- Some services/businesses may be closed or have limited hours
- Schedule errands and appointments 5-7 days prior
- Consider possible fuel shortages in the area
- Prepare for limited cellular service especially during the Eclipse Event
- Know when it is appropriate to call 911 (true emergencies)
  - Non-Emergency Police Department: 512-556-3644
  - Non-Emergency Sheriff's Office: 512-556-8255
- Expect a high volume of traffic and delays
- Keep emergency vehicles in mind when parking
- Be mindful of the Texas "Move Over" Law
- Parking may be limited
- Do not trespass on public properties that are closed
- Do not trespass on private property
- DO NOT look at the eclipse sun without proper optical devices (ISO certified 12312)
