## STATE OF TEXAS COUNTY OF LAMPASAS

## ORDER PROHIBITING OR RESTRICTING CERTAIN FIREWORK IN UNINCORPORATED AREAS OF LAMPASAS COUNTY, TEXAS

**WHEREAS**, the Texas Forest Service has determined that drought conditions may exist in <a href="Lampasas"><u>Lampasas</u></a> County; and

**WHEREAS**, on the 12<sup>th</sup> day of December 2022, the Commissioners Court of <u>Lampasas</u> County has determined that the normal danger of fire in the unincorporated areas of Lampasas County could greatly enhance by extremely dry conditions now existing;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the Commissioners Court of Lampasas County adopts this Order prohibiting the sale or use of restricted fireworks in the unincorporated areas of <u>Lampasas</u> County.

- A. A person may not sell, detonate, ignite, or in any way use fireworks classified as "skyrockets with sticks" under 49 C.F.R. part. 173.100(r)(2) (10-01-86 edition) or missiles with fins in any portion of the unincorporated areas of Lampasas County.
- B. This Order does not prohibit "permissible fireworks" as authorized in Occupants Code Section 2154.003(a).
- C. A person commits an offense if the person knowingly or intentionally violates a prohibition established by this Order. An offense under this order is a Class C. Misdemeanor.
- D. This order expires at midnight on January 1, 2023.
