**ORDER PROHIBITING OR RESTRICTING CERTAIN FIREWORK IN UNINCORPORATED AREAS OF
LAMPASAS COUNTY, TEXAS**


WHEREAS, the Texas Forest Service has determined that drought conditions may exist in Lampasas County; and

WHEREAS, on the 12th day of December 2022, the Commissioners Court of Lampasas County has determined that the normal danger of fire in the unincorporated areas of Lampasas County could greatly enhance by extremely dry conditions now existing;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Commissioners Court of Lampasas County adopts this Order prohibiting the sale or use of restricted fireworks in the unincorporated areas of Lampasas County.

- A. A person may not sell, detonate, ignite, or in any way use fireworks classified as “skyrockets with sticks” under 49 C.F.R. part. 173.100(r)(2) (10-01-86 edition) or missiles with fins in any portion of the unincorporated areas of Lampasas County.
- B. This Order does not prohibit “permissible fireworks” as authorized in Occupants Code Section 2154.003(a).
- C. A person commits an offense if the person knowingly or intentionally violates a prohibition established by this Order. An offense under this order is a Class C. Misdemeanor.
- D. This order expires at midnight on January 1, 2023.
