

# **IDENTIFICATION REQUIRED FOR TRANSFER OF PROPERTY**

## **SB 16 – Local Government Code 191.010(b)**

**(b) A County Clerk shall require a person presenting a document in person for filing in the real property records of the county to present a photo identification to the clerk. The clerk shall copy the photo identification or record information from the photo identification. The clerk may not charge a person a fee to copy for record the information from a photo identification.**

### **Acceptable Forms of Valid, Unexpired Identification:**

- Driver's license from a U.S. State
- Foreign Passport
- Law Enforcement employment ID (federal, state or city)
- Offender ID issued by the Texas Department of Criminal Justice
- An ID from a federal or U.S. state correctional facility or institution
- Department of Homeland Security, United States Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) issued:
  - Employment Authorization Document (EAD)
  - Travel Documents :
  - Advance Parole
  - U.S. Department State Issued:
  - Visa
- Federal or state ID card
- Pilot's License
- Military ID card
- License to Carry a Handgun
- Permanent Resident Card (Green Card)
- Refugee travel document
- U.S. citizen ID card
- Re-entry permit
- SENTRI card
- Border Crossing Card (BCC) B1 for business or pleasure or B2 medical purposes
